

**2.** Log in and create a new Kahoot.




Video: See what happens when Kahoot! is played in the classroom!


Log in and create a new Kahoot. The options are basically the same, so stick with the QUIZ choice.

Enter your questions and answer choices, marking which one is correct. You can set a time limit as well.


Then add a new question or save and continue.



Re-order the questions if you like. Then Save and Continue.



Provide a little more information. Then Save and Continue. And finally, click DONE.



Lastly, click PLAY and then LAUNCH. Users will have to put the game-pin into their Kahoot screen on their tablet. Kahoot isn't an app, so students can just navigate to the Kahoot website and input the game-pin. The teacher controls navigation to the next question. Students read the info on the overhead and then answer on their tablet.
